ABOUT NVMUN

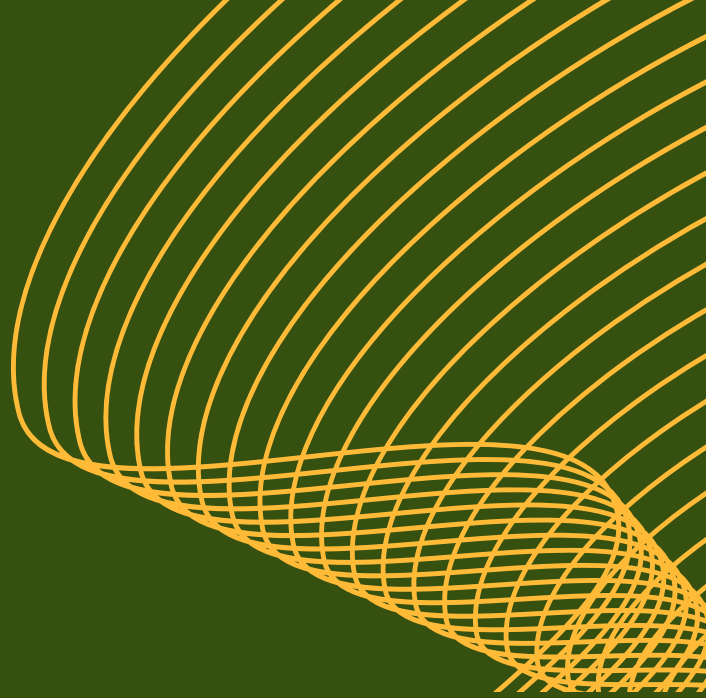

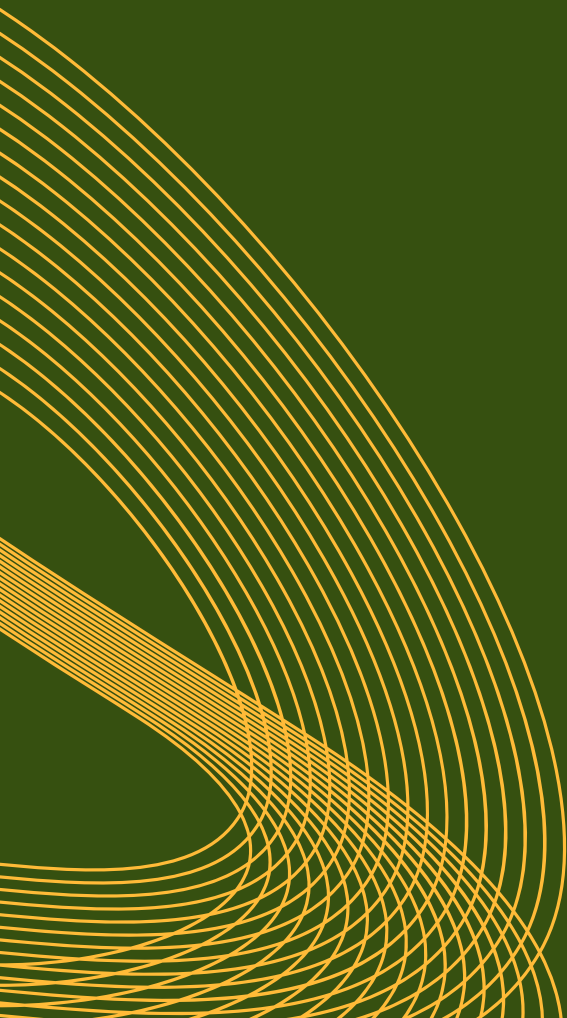
